Play is governed by the current **USGA Rules of Golf, the AzRC Local Rules and Conditions of Competition (aka The Hard Card), and the following Supplementary and Pace of Play Rules.**

FORMAT (Stroke Play): Describe Number of holes, format, purpose (ex: 36 Holes of individual stroke play to qualify 64 players for match play).

Format (Match Play): Describe Format, Purpose, (ex: Single match play over 4 days to determine the Arizona Amateur Champion).

TEEING GROUND(S): Define Tee Markers to be used

TIES: Define Procedure for deciding ties.

SCORING AREA: Define location and when score card is deemed returned.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Define any items in addition to the Items listed on the Hard Card.

DROPPING ZONES: Describe where Dropping Zones are located, and when they may be used.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS: Define anything that is to be treated as an immovable obstruction that may not always be considered an immovable obstruction and other factors such as when adjacent to another obstruction.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: Define any abnormal ground conditions and the procedure permitted (e.g. aeration holes, seams of curt turf)

PACE OF PLAY: Define pace rules in effect.

UNUSUAL CONDITIONS: Define any unusual conditions (LCP, restrictions on relief, mandatory relief situations, temporary immovable obstructions, One-Ball Rule, etc.)

COMMITTEE: List the members of the Committee responsible for appeals & phone contact during/after play.
